

## Gilbert Dye and Priscilla Harrill

Gilbert Dye was born May 5, 1803 in Rutherford Co, NC to Henry & Anna Dye. He married Priscilla Harrill on Dec 18, 1827 at Rutherford Co, NC. Priscilla was the daughter of Gilbert Harrill and Martha Washburn, she was born Jan 20, 1806 and died Nov 7, 1876 at Ozark Co, MO and is buried in Herndon Cemetery. Gilbert is said to have died on pneumonia on the trip to Missouri and died Feb 9, 1853.

Gilbert and Priscilla resided in Rutherford Co, NC, Spartanburg Co, SC (1840) and McMinn Co, TN (1850) after that Priscilla resided in Ozark Co, MO until her death in 1876.

About 1833, Gilbert and his brother, Thomas lost their land in Rutherford Co, NC to a court house sale and Gilbert moved to Spartanburg Co, SC where the Webber family was residing. He then lived near his brother, John, in McMinn Co, TN.

*Susan Ellen Wagner was born March 15, 1874 at Almartha, MO. to Zera Olden Parnell and Mary Ann Dye. Mrs. Wagner spent her early life at the family home in Missouri.*

*September 2, 1894 she was married to George Grant Ward in Ozark County, Missouri. They lived there and in Kansas until his death in 1901. They were the parents of four children: Zeb Washington Ward of Manville; Zera Nolan of Douglas, Effie who died in infancy, and Mrs Frank (Maude Clough) Quinn of Caldwell, Idaho.*

*On July 17, 1904 she was married to Samuel L. Wagner of Vera Cruz, Mo. They were the parents of two girls, Christeen Kobbe, Douglas and Mrs Clement (Anna Marie) Williamson of Quincy, Ill.*

*She was again widowed in 1933 and after a few years she left her home in Craig, Mo., and lived among her children, spending most of her time with her daughter, Christeen Kobbe of Douglas.*

They lived near Ava, MO. They lived in Fort Smith, AR for a time and later to Monett, MO. When Shipley died Sarah moved in with her daughter, in Monett, MO. Dicey and her husband, Harold Greaves owned the Frisco Hotel at the time. Sarah was injured when a portion of the ceiling fell and she died as a result of the injury.
