

James Dye, son of William Dye Sr.

James Dye was born in 1844 in Murphy, Cherokee Co, NC according to his civil war pension documentation. His parents were William D & Sarah Dye. His grandparents were Henry & Anna Dye. James was conscripted into Rebel Service in Pikeville TN, was reported AWOL, however, the Unit was disbanded, later he re-enlisted in Aug 1864 and was discharged from Union Service in 1865 with an honorable discharge. James married his cousin, Catherine "Jane" Dye. She was the daughter of John & Ailey Hill Dye. They married about 1868/1869 in Grundy Co, TN. They resided in Grundy Co, TN on the 1870 Census. John & Ailey were living in the same home. This home was close to the Perry G Dye Farm near Altamont, Tennessee. James and Jane had a son in 1870. Named for Jane's brother, Alfred Burton Dye. When Burton was two years old, Jane died about 1872 on the Sallie Pope Farm, and She was buried there near Dunlap, Sequatchie Co, TN. James Dye married Anna Sutherland on March 27, 1877 in Bledsoe Co, TN.

Anna's sister, Tennessee Sutherland married Perry D Dye. Aka young Perry, the son of Obediah & Cynthia Dye, Grandson of John & Ailey Hill Dye. James and Anna lived on the Sallie Pope Farm. They lived in Sequatchie Co, TN and moved to Hamilton Co, TN in Oct 1884 and resided on farms owned by Mrs. Sallie Pope.

Sallie Pope indicated in her affidavit, that James had lived on her place from boyhood and that his Father, had also lived on her farm. Lewis Shepherd was Sallie Pope's Grandson and he was a well known citizen of Hamilton Co, TN. Lewis Shepherd married Lila Pope in Sequatchie Co, Tn Dec 19, 1876. About 1895, The Couple moved from Tennessee to Dunklin Co, MO

James Dye died about March 8, 1899 in Dunklin Co, MO, his wife Anna died March 1901.

It is unknown where the couple were buried.

Alfred Burton Dye: Burton was born in Grundy Co, TN near Altamont in 1870 after the Census, to James & Jane Dye. He died on Jan 19, 1937 at Dunklin Co, MO and was buried at Pine City Cemetery. Burton married Lillie Mae Hawes on Aug 31, 1905 in Dunklin Co, MO.

Lillie was born Oct 31, 1880 in Dunklin Co, MO and died March 17, 1920. She was buried at Stanfield Cemetery at Dunklin Co, MO. Their children include:

Ruth Beatrice Dye b. Sep 7, 1908 at Dunklin Co, MO and died Jan 3, 1979 in Niles, Berrien Co, MI.

She married William Franklin Whitson Pugh. They are buried at Silverbrook Cemetery in Niles, MI., *Annie B Dye* b. Aug 20, 1911 d. Jan 19, 1983 in Niles, MI, After her sister died she married, her brother in law, William Franklin Whitson Pugh, all are buried at Silverbrook Cemetery in Niles, MI

Alfred Arlen "Bud" Dye b. Dec 12, 1913 d. Dec 21, 1972 buried at Stanfield Cemetery, Dunklin Co, MO, married Ethel Minnie Pugh b. Oct 4, 1914 d. April 29., 1996.

Thomas Dye b. 1918 d. Unknown

Gertie M Dye: Gertie Dye was born on the Sallie Pope Farm in Sequatchie Co, TN about 1879 and died in Dunklin CO, MO about 1900, soon after or when her son was born.

She married James D Dobbins in Clay Co, AR on July 2, 1896. They had a son, James Clarence Dobbins b. March 2, 1900 d. Sep 8, 1855 at Mt Vernon, Lawrence Co, MO. He resided at Sikeston, MO with a wife named Jessie. It appears he was being treated for TB, which required isolation at that time.

Pope Dye: Pope Dye was born June 1884 on the Sallie Pope Farm in Sequatchie Co, TN, according to his brother, Will, he died at age 26 (1909) in Dunklin Co, MO.

William H Dye: “Will” “Willie” b. January 1884. He married Lulu Essary Waltrip. They had Pauline, Carl, Ozell & Lucille Dye.

James O Dye: “Jimmy” was born Nov 1888 in Hamilton Co, TN on the Sallie Pope Farm, died at the age of 14 years old (1902) in Dunklin Co, MO. according to brother, Will Dye.

Sarah “Sallie” Dye: b. May 1891 Hamilton Co, TN, She had epilepsy & mental disabilities, she lived with her Sister, Gertie, until she died and then Aunt Tennie Dye, Burton, and then with Will before going to the State in Farmington, where she later died March 25, 1925 at the age of 33.

Charles Cicero Dye: Charles was born about 1894 near Tyner Station in Hamilton Co, TN on the Sallie Pope Farm. He married Nina Taylor on Nov 14, 1913 in Clarkton, Dunklin Co, MO.
